



## The Betty Endicott NATAS-NCCB Chapter Student Scholarship

The National Capital Chesapeake Bay Chapter of The National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences is pleased to announce its annual scholarship competition. The scholarship is in honor of Betty Endicott, the first female news director in Washington, DC.

Open to full-time undergraduate and graduate students pursuing careers in communications or broadcast journalism. Preference is given to those committed to a career in the broadcast news industry.

Scholarships will range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 (not to exceed \$5,000), depending on the number awarded.

NATAS is a non-profit organization dedicated to advancement in the television arts and sciences.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- Be enrolled in an accredited two or four year college or graduate program in Maryland, Virginia, or Washington, DC
- Be a full-time sophomore, junior or graduating senior with a declared major in communications or broadcast journalism
- Be a full-time graduate student in pursuit of an advanced degree in either communications or broadcast journalism
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Demonstrate an aptitude or interest in communication or broadcast news journalism through coursework, extracurricular activities, internships, jobs and volunteer work
